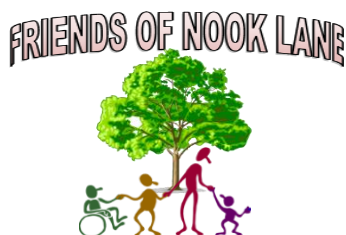

OUR AIMS

Families, friends, and community contacts known to the children of Nook Lane Junior are welcome members of the Friends of Nook Lane team. The team meets at least twice a term, approximately six times per year, with an Annual General Meeting held in October. OBJECTIVES

In all areas the group relies upon the support of families, staff, governors and friends of the school to reach its goals

REVIEW OF FINANCES OF FRIENDS OF NOOK LANE

ANNUAL ACCOUNT SHEET 2013-2014 PRESENTED AT AGM

- The group is responsible for its own finances and distribution
- It is guided by the Head of School and staff regarding the needs of the school and the children as a whole
- We work closely together to provide additional resources and improve facilities

THE CHARITIES ACTIVITIES

Over the previous years on behalf of our families our school charity **Friends of Nook Lane (FONL)** have donated to school monies including;

- RM Math Programmes = £1000 - £30 for playground football nets
- Sulp Primary Books = £795 - £50 for netball equipment
- Outdoor Learning / Quad benches = £1,100 - £59.84 for footballs
- £190 for sports equipment - £150 banner for interschool events
- £140 for Baby Belling ovens - £350 netball court

So far, towards our **Teacher's Wish Lists** we have donated:

- X5 Cameras for recording children's learning achievements = £450
- X12 Laptops for research = £1,000

TOTAL FOR OUR CHILDREN'S EDUCATION

= £5,314.84

In the near future FONL are focusing on gaining funding, help and donations to create a **new playground, Sensory Room and indoor area for our children living with learning, communication, and language challenges in our Integrated Resource**
